Adding Canon Copiers on a Mac

- 1. Make sure the computer is connected to the Fac/Staff wireless Network
- 2. Install the driver for the Sharp Copiers
 - a. Download the driver by navigating to www.usa.canon.com
 - b. Click on **Support & Drivers** on the bottom left bar
 - c. Under the Product Type menu, select Office Equipment
 - d. Under the Product Family menu, select the printer model **Color imageRunner Advance**
 - e. Under the Product Series menu, select the machine (either imageRunner ADVANCE C5240 or imageRunner Advance C5250)
 - f. You will be taken to the Drivers & Software page. Under the Operating System dropdown menu, select your current operating system
 - g. Download the latest UFR II driver and install it by opening the downloaded folder and starting the install file. Use all of the default options
 - NOTE: You may be asked administrator credentials
- 3. Once the driver is installed, you can set up the printer by navigating to **System Preferences** (In Lion, you will need to click on the **IP Tab**) >>> **Print & Fax** >>> +

NOTE: In Lion, you will need to click on the IP Tab

Adding Canon Copiers on a Mac (Continued)

- 4. Enter the following printer information
 - a. In the Address input box, enter the Printer server IP address: 10.1.1.69
 - b. In the Queue input box, enter the share name, (Wismer Copier)
 - c. In the Name input box, enter the same location as above.
 - d. In the Print Using drop down menu, select Select Printer Software
 - e. In the Print Software window that pops up, select the software that you downloaded. This should be named as the model of the printer
 - f. Click Add
- 5. You will need to set up the Job Handling for your Canon Copier
 - g. You can do this by opening the printer and selecting **Options & Supplies**
 - h. Select **Utility**
 - i. Select Open Printer Utility
 - j. Select **Use Department ID Management** and enter 0 + your department number (e.g. 01234)
 - k. Select Save Settings
