

FAFSA IRS Data Retrieval


Step 1:


- Sign into the FAFSA and on the homepage select that you wish to "Make A Correction to an Existing FAFSA." Select the appropriate year.
- Once you are inside the FAFSA, select "Financial Information" on the menu bar. (Figure 1-1)

- On the Financial Information page, answer the IRS Data Retrieval Tool questions appropriately. If the IRS determines you are eligible, you can perform the Data Retrieval. Click on the "Link to IRS" button. (Figure 1-2)



 To determine if you can use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer your tax return information from the IRS into your FAFSA, answer the following question(s):

Did you file a Form 1040X amended tax return?

Leaving FAFSA on the Web

You are now leaving *FAFSA on the Web* and will be transferred to the IRS Web site to access your IRS tax information. Your FAFSA information will be saved.

Your saved FAFSA will automatically open either when you transfer your information from the IRS or choose to return to *FAFSA on the Web* from the IRS Web site. If you do not transfer your information or choose not to return to *FAFSA on the Web* from the IRS Web site, you will have to log in to open your saved FAFSA.

Click **OK** to continue. Otherwise, click **Cancel**.

- Click "Ok" to agree to the authorized use page. (Figure 2-1)

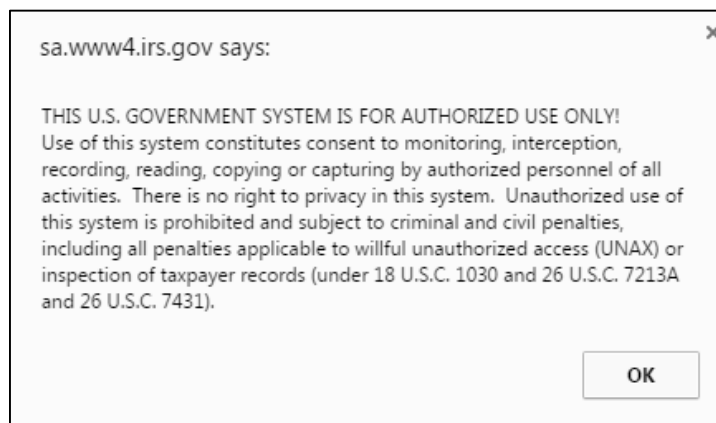

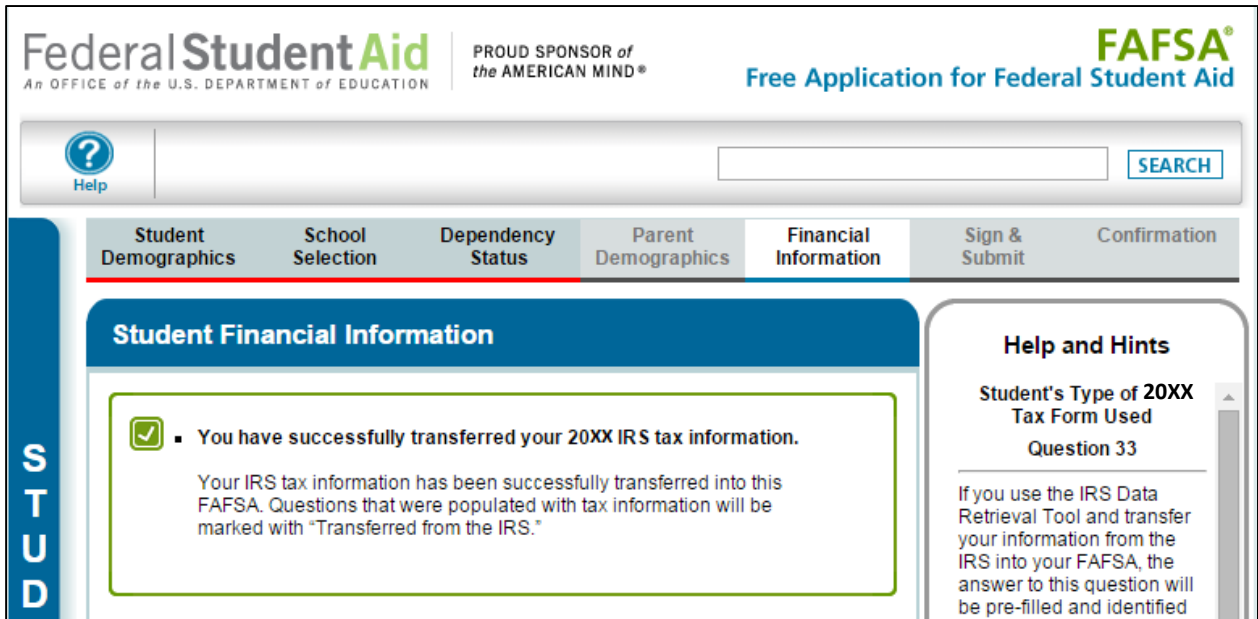

Step 3:

- You will be directed back to the FAFSA. It is important that you **do not change the financial information that was imported from the IRS**. On the top menu bar, click "Sign & Submit". (Figure 3-1)

- Under the "Sign & Submit" page, you will be notified that you have made changes and that your application was saved (Figure 3-2). Click "Next" at the bottom of the page. (Figure 3-3)

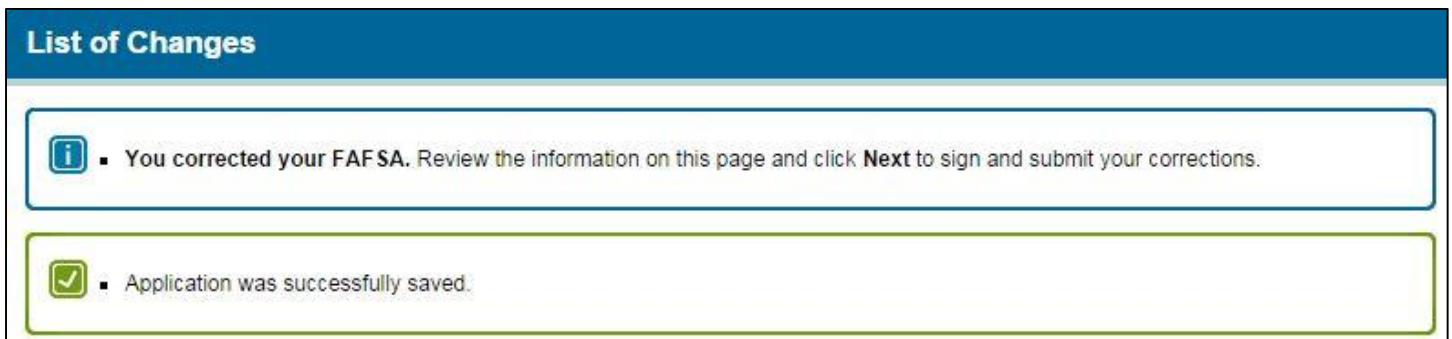

- Once we receive your FAFSA we may contact you if we determine that additional documentation is needed.
