STANDARDIZED TESTING

All applicants to The Master's University, including those who apply from foreign countries, are required to take either the Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT I) or the ACT of the American University Testing Program. When you register for these tests, remember to request that official score results be sent to The Master's University. Our University Board (SAT) number is **4411** and our ACT code is **0303**. If standardized testing is repeated, only your highest scores are considered. Only the Math and Critical Reasoning sub-tests of the SAT will be considered.
